- **ONLY TRADITIONAL FORMS WILL BE ALLOWED** (does not apply to weapons).
- Forms should be performed at the appropriate belt level. Color Belts should not do Black Belt Forms etc. We expect differences in what forms are taught for different levels, regardless, forms will be judged by the criteria below
- Forms will be judged by stance, sharp technique, focus, breathing, kiap, and spirit.
- No competition Forms will be allowed. The following is a list of acceptable forms.

Should a question arise over a form meeting traditional requirements the tournament director, Master Pumarejo or the senior ranking Master in attendance will settle all disputes or questions arising in forms divisions.

### **Forms Judging Information**

**Color Belts** will have Three Black Belt Judges for forms

**Black Belts** will have Three 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree Black Belt or higher Judges, preferably 4<sup>th</sup> Degree Black Belt (Master) if available.

**Forms Grand Champion** will have Five 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree Black Belt or higher Judges, preferably 4<sup>th</sup> Degree Black Belt (Master) if available.

**Only Black Belts can compete for Grand Champion.**

## Weapons Forms Information

Allowed weapons include: Nunchucks, Staff, Knife, Sword, Sai, and Kamas. Other weapons will be allowed at judge's discretion. Forms will be judged by stance, focus, breathing, balance, spirit, weapon handling, and sharp technique. Live Blades by permission only.

## Division Information

### **Ranking**

Different Tang Soo Do Federations use different Ranking/Color Belts for use within their federation. Please use the chart below to find your appropriate level. If in doubt, go by your gup level.

4. **Adult Women's Black Belt Sparring Grand Champion (18 & Up):** All 1<sup>st</sup> Place Women's Sparring Division winners
5. **Junior & Youth Sparring Grand Champion (8-12 & 13-17 yr old):** All 1<sup>st</sup> Place Junior & Youth Sparring Division winners (Male/Female)

## WDU / Tucson Korean Martial Arts Championship Sparring Rules

1. **REQUIRED SPARRING GEAR:** Head, hands, feet protection, and mouthpieces are mandatory. Foam Dipped gear is the recommended style, however, if a competitor wears a suitable substitution that meets the level of protection of foam dipped gear, it is acceptable as deemed by the head judge. Feet may be bootie style or shin/instep style. Groin cups are mandatory for men/boys only. Chest protectors are optional.
2. Competitors cannot choose who they spar and must be drawn randomly. Allowances may be made so that competitors from the same school do not spar in the first round of competition.
3. **LENGTH OF MATCH:** The length of a match will be two minutes running-time unless a competitor is seven points ahead in the black belt divisions (Seven Point Spread Rule) before time has expired. If the competitors are Gup rank, then the match is 2 minutes unless a competitor is 5 points ahead (5 Point Spread Rule).
  - A. If a match is tied at the end of two minutes, a sudden victory (first person to score a point) overtime period will determine the winner.
  - B. At the 1 minute 45 second mark of a sparring match, the timekeeper will shout out “FIFTEEN SECONDS”.
4. **WHAT IS A SPARRING POINT:** A point is a Tang Soo Do technique that is scored by a competitor in-bounds and upright (not considered down) without time being called that strikes a competitor with the allowable amount of focused touch contact and focused control to a legal target area.
  - A. Green belts and below may come within 4 inches of the head/face to score a point.
  - B. Red Belts must be within 2 inches of the head/face area.
  - C. Black belts may make contact to score.
    - I. **Focused Touch Contact:** the legal amount of contact allowed to certain scoring areas.
    - II. **Focused Control:** an amount of controlled force that would have incapacitated the opponent, at least momentarily, if the technique had not been controlled.
  - D. Any contact that incapacitated the opponent; i.e. Knockout’s, causes a concussion, or the opponent cannot continue, will be deemed as Hard Contact and will be a penalty / illegal technique, unless it is a No-Fault contact.
  - E. All techniques are 1 point.
5. **LEGAL TECHNIQUES:** All punches to the body and controlled punches to the head (black belts only), controlled (no spinning or blind techniques) to the side of the head only, ridge hands that stop on the side of the head only and do not continue through to the face especially the eye area, and all kicks to legal target areas. Open hand techniques such as palm strikes and spear hands are not allowed. Elbows, knees, and strikes to illegal target areas are not allowed.
6. **NO FAULT CONTACT:** Unintentional contact can occur that injures a competitor, which can be classified as no-fault contact. Judges may vote on a penalty being called No-Fault Contact. The injury can be declared No-Fault, by the majority vote of judges. This means no penalty point or disqualification can occur.
7. **TARGET AREAS:**
  - A. **Legal Target Areas:** Front and Sides of Head and face, ribs, chest, abdomen, collarbone, and kidneys. The back of the head is not a legal target area, however if a controlled technique was thrown to a legal target area, but the competitor flinched or turned their head to avoid the contact then it is a legal target area.
  - B. **Illegal Target Areas:** Spine, back of neck, throat, sides of the neck, groin, legs, knees, and back.
  - C. **Non-Target Areas:** Hips, shoulders, buttocks, arms, and feet.
8. A competitor is considered out of bounds when they have one foot off the sparring area (mat or marked area). Neither opponent can score if one opponent is deemed out of bounds. The only exception is a combination technique, without stopping, that started with both opponents in bounds and one opponent

retreated in response, a point will be counted only if it was the result of the combination even if it is out of bounds.

9. If a competitor goes out of bounds while the other competitor is kicking or punching, near the competitor WITHOUT actually touching the competitor, the competitor will be considered leaving the sparring area to avoid competition. 1<sup>st</sup> occurrence center referee will bring opponents back to center of ring and verbally advise competitor that a 2<sup>nd</sup> occurrence will result in a warning and a 3<sup>rd</sup> occurrence will result in the other competitor receiving a point. A fighter must stay engaged in the match if he goes out of bounds not to be penalized.
10. If a fighter touches the ground/mat with, with any part of their body, except their feet or 1 hand, they are considered down.
11. A point cannot be scored on a down competitor and a downed competitor cannot score a point. If an upright competitor strikes a down competitor or they can be penalized by losing a point or disqualification.
12. All Legal Techniques are 1 point in value.
13. On a call, a majority of judges are required to score a point. This means that if 3 judges are present, 2 judges must be calling for a point for it to be scored. If 5 judges are present, 3 judges must call for a point for it to be scored. Casting a “No see”, “clash”, or “no call” all effectively mean no point. Ex: 3 judges are present, 1 judge calls 1-point red, 2 judges call “NO SEE” so no point is awarded because a majority is not present for the point.
14. **Leg Checks and Sweeps:** Leg checks that are not meant to take down an opponent, but only to check the front leg at mid-calf or below and obstruct the balance so as to follow up with a Tang Soo Do technique are allowed.
  - A. Controlled Takedowns and sweeps that are meant to take down an opponent are not allowed.
  - B. A point is awarded only when the legal leg check is followed up effectively legally and immediately with an appropriate Tang Soo Do technique.
15. The following can result in a warning and penalty point to the other side.
  - A. Going out of bounds to avoid competition
  - B. Falling down to avoid competition
  - C. Running around the ring to avoid competition (not actively engaged)
  - D. Excessive contact as deemed by a majority of judges
  - E. Pushing a competitor out of bounds (not to be confused with fighting out)
  - F. Attacking illegal and non-target areas
  - G. Attacking with Blind or Illegal techniques
  - H. Uncontrolled or Wild techniques
  - I. Unsportsmanlike behavior to either another fighter or judge
  - J. Late Hits
  - K. Retaliatory hits
  - L. Coaching from the sideline (Coaching is not allowed)
16. **Disqualification:** A 2<sup>nd</sup> Warning for the same thing will result in a point deduction, after the 2<sup>nd</sup> warning for anything, a competitor will be disqualified. Any other infractions constitute penalty points as stated above. The center referee has an authority to disqualify any competitor that is behaving in an unsportsmanlike or in a disrespectful manner
17. **Blood:** The drawing of blood is not an instant disqualification. If it is deemed that the drawing of blood is from incidental contact or; a technique with good focused control was thrown and the carelessness of the other competitor caused the excessive force or drawing of blood then there is no disqualification. A penalty point may be awarded for the excessive contact as deemed appropriate. If

the contact was malicious in nature or due to reckless/uncontrolled technique then a competitor may be disqualified if there is a majority consensus by the judges.

**18.** Sparring Grand Champion same procedures as Black Belts divisions.

**19. JUMP FRONT KICK COMPETITION:** Jump Front Kick is scored by having a kicking pad raised each time the competitors kicked. When a competitor cannot kick the target, they are out of the competition. The top 3 finishers will be awarded 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, & 3<sup>rd</sup> Place.
